### **CONDUCT AT CAG MEETINGS**

All participants agree to follow the Co-Chair's guidance regarding conduct at meetings and adhere to the following guidelines:

- A. Be on time, respecting the schedule of other members.
- B. Listen as an ally, not as an adversary. Listen with an open mind and heart – it allows deeper understanding and, therefore, progress.
- C. Speak one at a time; interruptions and side conversations are distracting and disrespectful to the speaker.
- D. Be concise. Speak only once on a particular issue, unless you have new or different information to share.
- E. Ask for clarification; don't assume you know what someone means.
- F. Disagree respectfully and openly, not in private.
- G. Focus on the issue, not the speaker – personalizing makes it impossible to listen effectively.
- H. Treat each other with respect, as you would like to be treated.
- I. Allow all Members to participate equally, avoid dominating.
- J. Honor time limits.

- K. Observers may speak during observer comment periods as designated on the meeting agenda.
- L. Turn off all beepers and cell phones; take or make all calls outside the room.
