BoRit Asbestos NPL Site Weekly Summary – week of 12/28/09

REMOVAL OPERATIONS UPDATE

Work completed week of 12/28/2009:

- 1. Received approximately <u>2.5</u> inches of rain from storm on Friday and Saturday (12/25/09 and 12/26/09).
- 2. Inspection revealed no apparent impacts to the Phase I area along Wissahickon Creek; however, some additional (minor) erosion of topsoil was observed on the Rose Valley upper bank (park side) near the South gate.
- 3. Continued surveying/marking of elevations and grading along the Rose Valley Creek area (prior to installation of concrete cable mats).
- 4. Continued installation of concrete cable mats along the Rose Valley Creek area.
- 5. No clean fill was delivered to the site this week. As of 12/23/09, a total of 1,991 truckloads (approximately 29,865 cubic yards) had been delivered to the site . . . clean fill delivery will continue the first two week of January. We do not expect to receive any more fill after that.
- 6. As of 12/30/09, a total of 93 loads of ACM and organic debris have been sent to the landfill . . . I do not have the latest weight numbers yet.
- 7. Due to lack of intrusive activities and recent precipitation, no particulate monitoring or stationary air sampling was performed this week.
- 8. Continued dust suppression activities as needed.

Work scheduled for week of 01/04/2009:

- 1. Continue installation of the cable concrete mats along the Rose Valley Creek area.
- 2. Continue minor excavation of the streambed and collection of ACM debris from Rose Valley Creek and the reservoir bank/berms.
- 3. Continue dust suppression activities as needed.

REMEDIAL OPERATIONS UPDATE

1. The remedial contractor was off-site this week. Field activities will resume next week.
