

Public Comments on the Groundwater Contamination Document

On behalf of the Community Advisory Committee for the Bo-Rit Superfund site in Ambler and adjoining areas I would like to invite any interested parties to read and comment on the [The Groundwater Health Consultation](#) document. This is a Health Consultation prepared by the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Federal Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR). The document, which is out for public comment addresses any risks to public health from groundwater contamination resulting from the BoRit superfund site. This site is very heavily contaminated with asbestos and other substances. [The Groundwater Health Consultation](#) will be one of the documents used by EPA to determine how to make the site safe for future use.

At this time we are collecting comments from people who we think are interested in the issue, and who have diverse backgrounds. On behalf of the Committee I will collate these and we will submit them to the agencies for their consideration. Armed with the public comments they will issue a final report on this matter.

I hope that you will be willing and able to help us. Your comments can be as brief as you wish. I would like to receive your input by September 20 , so that they may be collated and submitted before the comment period closes.
